ORDINANCES

1. Substitution of Sr. No. 3 under the Head IX-Faculty of Home Science in 0.2 page 73 of H.B. Pt. II 1984 and subsequently substituted/amended/added vide Pamphlet Nos. 1, 4, 5, 7, and 8.

(S.R. No. 16 of 30.6.94 and S.R. No. 23 of 23.12.94)

Sr. No. 3 under the Head IX Faculty of Home Science has been substituted to read as under :

2. Addition of new 0.30-B after 0.30-A on page No. 91 of H.B.Pt. II 1984 (S.R. No. 18 of 30-6-94, S.R. No. 12 of 21-10-94 and S.R. No. 36 of 23.12.94.

0.30-B after 0.30-A has been added to read as under :

- (a) The appointment of the Director, Centre for Continuing/Adult Education and Community Services be made by rotation for a period not exceeding three years at a time by the Syndicate. The appointment shall not be made for more than two terms of three years each.

- (b) Such appointment should be made from amongst the Teachers of the University as per following criteria :
- (i) A person with outstanding contribution in the field of Adult Continuing Education and Extension work OR a person with atleast ten years experience in the said discipline, out of which 3 to 5 years experience in Adult & Continuing Education and Extension Work.
 - (ii) Ph.D. in his/her discipline preferably in area of Social Science or in area allied to Adult Education or equivalent research work or publication to his/her credit.
 - (iii) An individual with vision/ideas for introducing and conductive innovative courses and ability to liaison with industries/institutions.
 - (iv) A Teacher who meets with the qualifications prescribed for the appointment of professor in the University.
- (c) Recommendations of the appointment be made by a Standing Committee of the following members:
1. Vice-Chancellor
 2. Pro-Vice-Chancellor
 3. Four experts to be nominated by the Syndicate
 4. Two Deans to be nominated by the Syndicate
- (d) In addition to the criteria mentioned in (b) above, the following points are also to be observed while making recommendations by the Committee :
- (i) Seniority as Teacher
 - (ii) Academic leadership
 - (iii) Administrative capacity
 - (iv) Organisational ability
 - (v) Rapport with the colleague Teachers, Students and the Public.
- (e) The Teacher so appointed will be full time Professor and Director in the Centre and the expenditure of his/her salary will be charged against the post of Professor of the Centre. However he/she will be allowed to maintain the lien on his/her original post and he/she be allowed to take some teaching workload in his parent Department.

- (f) Notwithstanding anything contained above, the Vice-Chancellor shall be authorised to appoint any teacher of the Centre/Faculty concerned as Officiating Director in order to carry on the duties of the Director of the Centre when the same is vacated by death, resignation etc. or when the Director appointed under the norms proceeds on leave or duty leave.

3. Addition/substitution in O.198 B under the head Faculty of Technology and Engineering on page No.164 of H.B. Pt. II, 1984 subsequently substituted/amended/added vide Pamphlet Nos. 1, 2, 7, 8 and 11. (S.R. No. 39 of 28-12-94)

- A- The following para has been added below the Note appearing under the prescribed qualifications for the post of Reader :

The candidates having Ph.D./Post doctoral research and minimum 8 years experience of teaching/research industries with at least second class (50%) at Master's level be also considered eligible for the posts in Science and Humanities.

- B- The Note appearing under the prescribed qualifications for the post of Professor has been substituted to read as under :

NOTE : The candidates from Industry/Profession/Teaching/Research Institutions with recognised professional/Research Work /Innovation in Teaching Material/Method/Publication of high standard recognised at national/International level equivalent to Doctorate would also be eligible.

4. Amendment of O.209 (8) Duty Leave on page No. 217 of H.B. Pt. II, 1984 subsequently revised vide Pamphlet No. 11. (S.R. No. 2 (6) of 31.1.95)

O.209 (3) has been amended to read as under :

No other leave except due leave or duty leave upto 15 days will be granted till completion of six months limited to 30 days in year as provided in rules No. 4.2 of O.209 from the date of joining services after availing of previous leave.

5. Amendment in Clause No. (ii) (a and b) and addition of clause (viii) after clause No. (vii) in 0.221 on page No. 236 of H.B. Pt. II, 1984 subsequently substituted vide Pamphlet No. 4.

(S.R. No. 16 of 21-10-94 and S.R. No. 12 of 23-12-94.)

Clause No. (ii) (a and b) of 0.221 has been amended to read as under w.e.f. the academic year 1995.96.

- (ii) (a) Every year Six Research Scholarships of the value of Rs. 800/- per month each, tenable for a period of 3 years with an annual contingent grant of Rs. 1500/- towards expenses on apparatus, chemicals, equipment, books, journals, photostate copies, micro-films, typing (including thesis), stationery, postage, field work/travel etc. may be awarded.
- (b) Every year Four Post-doctoral Fellowships of the value of Rs. 1200/- p.m. each tenable for a period of one year only may be awarded. The Post-doctoral Fellowship will carry a contingent grant of Rs. 2500/- per annum for approved contingent expenditure.

Clause No. (viii) after Clause No (vii) in 0.221 has been added to read as under :

- (viii) If the award/s of university Post-Doctoral Fellowship remain unutilised for want of applicants, the same be diverted to university Research Scholarship and be offered to the eligible applicants.

6. Addition in 0.234 and 0.234 A on Page No. 243 of H.B. pt.II 1984 subsequently substituted vide Pamphlet No. 2. (S.R. No. 27 of 21-2-94)

Sr.No. (j) after Sr. No. (i) in 0.234 has been added to read as under :

- (j) Dy. Chief Warden, Halls of Residence

Sr. No. (e) after Sr. No. (d) in 0.234 A has been added to read as under :


- (e) Dy. Chief Warden, Halls of Residence.

7. Addition of clause (d) after Clause (i) (c) In 0.282 on page No. 318 of H.B. pt. ii , 1984 subsequently added vide Pamphlet No. 1. (S. R. No. 20 of 31-1-95)

Clause (d) after clause (i) (c) in 0.282 has been added to read as under :

- (d) Notwithstanding what is stated above, the benefit of 0.282 (i) (a) be given to the candidates of Master's Degree final examination, whose total falls short by 1, 2 or 3 marks to get 55% and the same be counted in counting the percentage.
